The purpose of this "**June 2022 - Activity Monthly Report**" is to provide the Mayor, City Council Members, and City Administrator with a detailed report of the services provided by the Kemah Police Department for the performance of the month of **June 2022**. In summary, your Kemah Police Department engaged in **\*1189** positive citizen contacts/interactions and handled **3929** enforcement service-related calls, performed a total of **1038** security checks, and generated a total of **58** Offense/Incident Reports. Additionally, the Kemah Police Department completed **316** total Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) related calls for service and executed a total of **14** felony and misdemeanor warrants. Our Police Officers self-initiated **3282** calls for service.

Concerning traffic law enforcement, our officers issued **231** traffic-related citations and/or warnings, **60** citations to female citizens, and **171** citations to male citizens. K.P.D. received **56** hours of free law enforcement (public safety) services from reserved police officers, volunteers, and/or interns.

In addition, this report will encompass an incident summary category which will provide a brief synopsis of any significant incidents that have occurred during the evaluation month. The information accumulated will be utilized to identify spatial concentrations of significant incidents or offenses that required the generation of a police report by City of Kemah Police Department Personnel.
