DISTURBANCE AND PHYSICAL ALTERCATION RESULT IN FELONY APPREHENSION BY THE KEMAH POLICE

On April 6th, 2024, at approximately 02:00 am, the Kemah Police Department received a report of a disturbance in the 500 block of Kipp Avenue. Upon arrival, officers observed a physical altercation between two males and attempted to intervene. During their intervention, one of the males fled the scene and was pursued by officers on foot. While in pursuit, two unidentified females obstructed the arrest. One of the females was detained while the other, accompanied by a Hispanic male named Jeremiah Hernandez, physically assaulted an officer while resisting arrest.

Despite the initial altercation, the officers pursued Hernandez north on Bradford Ave. At Bradford Ave and 6th Street, they attempted to take him into custody. However, Hernandez resisted arrest once again and assaulted another officer before fleeing. Additional resources and officers were called in to assist in the search for Hernandez.

The search for Hernandez eventually led officers south on Kipp Ave., where he was discovered hiding under a residence stairway at Bradford Ave. and 8th Street. He was subsequently taken into custody without further incident.

The Kemah Police Department expressed gratitude to the community for its continued cooperation and support in maintaining law and order in the city. The department also commended the bravery and dedication of the officers involved in the capture of Hernandez and will continue to uphold its commitment to protecting the community and maintaining public safety.
