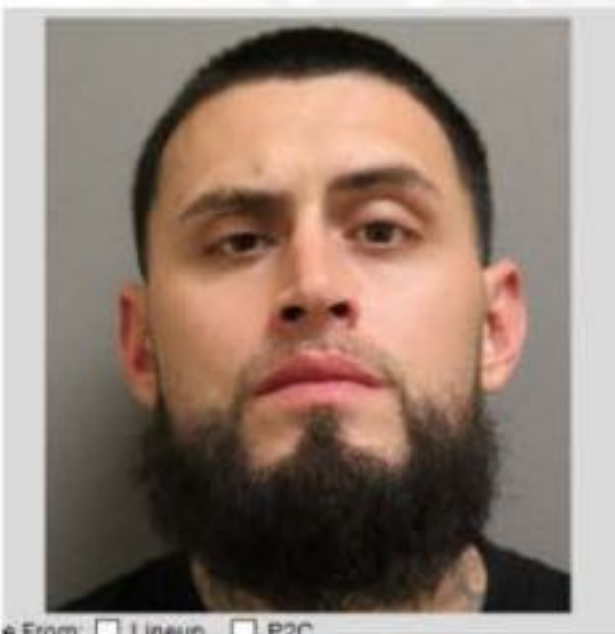
TRAFFIC STOP RESULTS IN FELONY APPREHENSION BY THE KEMAH POLICE

On April 5th, 2024, the Kemah Police Department conducted routine patrols in the area of State Highway 146 when they noticed a speeding vehicle on the elevated bypass in the 1000 block. They decided to take action and initiated a traffic stop. The driver, Carlos Tomas Aguirre, complied by pulling over on the elevated bypass in the 1400 block next to Bel Road.

During their interaction with Aguirre, the officers discovered a clear, crystalized substance that was later confirmed to be methamphetamine. The officers conducted a thorough search of the vehicle and found additional drugs and drug-related paraphernalia located inside the car, near the driver and passenger seats.

The officers' successful efforts led to the seizure of 4.5 grams of Methamphetamine, .95 grams of multi-colored pills, and 88.11 grams of a powdery substance. Aguirre was taken into custody without further incident and charged with Manufacturing and Delivering a Controlled Substance, reflecting the seriousness of the offense.

The Kemah Police Department commends the bravery and dedication of the officers involved in the arrest of Aguirre. Their successful efforts ensured the community remained safe and secure. The department would like to express its gratitude to the community for their continued cooperation and support in their efforts to maintain law and order in the city of Kemah.
